

White Lotus Tattoo Aftercare

10-14 days is the normal healing time for tattoos. <u>At the first sign of an adverse reaction or infection, i.e. excessive swelling,</u> <u>fever, or rash, please contact White Lotus and consult a physician.</u>

1. Remove all bandages in two hours. Do not re-bandage.

2. Wash your hands thoroughly. With clean hands, gently wash your tattoo with warm water and mild soap (Dr. Bronner's, Aveeno, etc). Gently wash and rinse away all blood and plasma from your tattoo.

3. Allow your tattoo to air dry. Pat dry any excess water with CLEAN paper towel.

4. Once tattoo is dry, using clean hands, apply a THIN layer of Aquaphor Ointment on your tattoo. Blot off excess ointment with clean paper towel.

6. Repeat washing two times daily, for 2-5 days, or until blood or plasma is no longer present.

7. After each wash, apply a THIN layer of Aquaphor daily until tattoo is smooth. If you prefer, after 3 days, you can switch from Aquaphor to a mild, fragrance-free and dye-free lotion (Alba, Lubriderm, etc.).

6. Use a fragrance-free and dye-free lotion for the remainder of the healing.

7. Do not use petroleum jelly, alcohol, or any home remedies.

8. While healing, avoid pet hair, sun exposure, steam, salt water, chlorine, dirt, grease, or soaking in water. **These things can cause reaction, irritation, and infection.**

9. Do not pick at your tattoo. Allow Flakes to fall off naturally.

10. While healing, wear loose clothing as to not irritate tattoo.
